What is it?

The New Mexico Hispanic Youth Symposium is a four-day, three-night college empowerment program that will provide you the tools and resources you need to become a better student, go to college, and get into a great career. During the symposium you will:

- Participate in workshops focused on how to apply for college and get financial aid
- Participate in workshops focused on careers in local companies, agencies, and organizations
- Meet college admissions counselors from top universities
- Learn about how your cultural heritage contributes to your academic success
- Compete for college scholarships in art, talent, and speech competitions

Eligibility Requirements

- Have a 2.5 GPA or above
- Be in the class of 2012 or 2013
- Live and attend high school in the state of New Mexico
- Complete the online application

If you are accepted into the program, you will be asked to submit a \$10 personal investment fee (waivers are available). Transportation will be provided.

How do I apply?

- Go to www.hispanicyouth.org.
- Create an account.
- Enter all of the required information - **Important:** When completing the application, please supply the required information, such as your email and mailing address, as accurately as possible. This information will be used later to communicate with you (i.e. acceptance packets, emails, transportation information, etc...).
- You can save your work if you cannot complete the application at one time.
- Once you have finished the application, click submit. After you submit your application, you will not be able to make any changes to it online.
- You will receive confirmation of acceptance into the program in Spring 2010.
